

Family Day Center

The Family Day Center is a welcoming, safe refuge from the streets for families experiencing homelessness. Families can find a helping hand, a listening ear and basic services such as showers, laundry, kitchen facilities, computer stations and same day Coordinated Entry assessments. A case manager is on site to help connect families with family shelter beds and other resources.

Families experiencing homelessness can drop in anytime within these hours

Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday: 9:00 am - 4:00 pm
Wednesday: Noon to 6:00 pm

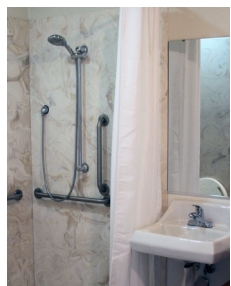

Eligibility for Services

Households with minor children experiencing homelessness, and pregnant women. *We provide equal access to our services without regard to race, gender, sexual orientation, marital status, religion, national origin, or disability.*



Showers

Two private bathrooms includes a wheelchair-accessible shower and bathtub. Toiletries and towels are available.

Laundry

Families can do one load of laundry each day. Supplies are provided.



Kitchen Facilities

Stove, microwave, refrigerators, pots & pans, plates, silverware, cups are available for use.



Computer Stations

Computers and a printer, phone and WiFi are available for family use.

Coordinated Entry - Same Day Appointment

Families with children can drop in at the Day Center for a same-day Coordinated Entry appointment. This is the first step to seek assistance for anyone experiencing homelessness in Pierce County. It begins with a problem-solving conversation with a Specialist to explore options to quickly resolve the crisis. If a quick resolution is not identified, the household enters the "prioritization pool" for potential referral to a homeless service provider.



Family Friendly Space with Supportive Services

The Family Day Center is a family friendly, safe space. Families are welcome to use the services in a warm welcoming environment. A specialist is present to provide Coordinated Entry assessments and connection to resources and housing stability planning.
