Pierce County brings free testing to you.

Volunteers help you register on site. No ID required. Results in 5-7 days.

Anyone can get tested.

It's important to get tested if you:

- Experience fever, chills, cough, shortness of breath, fatigue, muscle pain, headache, loss of taste or smell, sore throat, stuffy or runny nose, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea.
- Were close to a person with COVID-19 or attended a gathering with many people.
- Are a member of an at-risk community—Black, Latinx, Hawaiian, Pacific Islander, American Indian or Alaska Native.
